Experiment with tone by drawing light/dark lines	Paint with increasing accuracy and skill

	Create names for own colours created e.g. sunshine yellow

 Create a picture independently using mark making tools e.g. brush, pen Use a camera to take photographs (in groups with adult support) 	• Use a variety of materials, both natural and man-made to create simple sculptures/models e.g. paper sculptures
Ask questions about an artist and find the answers using the internet	Work safely with a variety of materials and tools e.g. scissors, wire, playdough
Copy, paste and print a portrait of their chosen artist	Manipulate materials in a variety of ways e.g. rolling, kneading, folding

Create a print through rubbing over objects	Thread large eyed needles and use different sized running stitches to draw with
Create a symmetrical print	Join fabric using glue and staples
Design and create their own simple printing block (cutting a shape into	Use a simple running stitch to sew two pieces of fabric together
potatoes, sponge, polystyrene, card etc.)	Apply decorative finishes to their work e.g. beads, buttons, feathers
