


In order to cover the cost of resources/equipment, and to pay Mrs Whipp for her time, the club will cost £25 for the 6 weeks.

# Congratulations on our SAT results for 2023

We wanted to say a huge congratulations to our Y6 children from last year, whose SAT results were phenomenal—with 80% of the cohort achieving the expected standard in reading, writing and maths combined - at only 3 other primary schools, from the 64 in St Helens -

meaning that only 3 other primary schools, from the 64 in St Helens - all from other areas outside of Billinge achieved higher.

17% of our children achieved greater depth in reading, writing and maths combined - this the highest percentage of children achieving greater depth in the local area.

In terms of progress scores which track progress from Y2 to Y6, our Y6 children achieved well above average progress in reading (+3.5) and maths (+5.1) the best progress measures in the local area.

These super results are testament to both the children's and teachers' hard work and we are really proud of them all.

Our current Y6 children are working very hard to prepare for this year's SAT tests in May. They are all making super progress and we are sure that their end results will be a true reflection of their desire to be the best that they can be. We can't ask anymore of them.
