| Flavour | Tally | Number of Children |
|------------|-------|--------------------|
| Chocolate | | 20 |
| Vanilla | | 12 |
| Strawberry | | 16 |
| Mint | | 4 |
| Banana | | 8 |

- b) Children should notice that the numbers in the table are all multiples of 2 and 4. They could use either scale for their pictogram.
- 2) Children use an appropriate scale (either 4 children or 2 children for every symbol) and a suitable symbol to accurately represent the data.
- 3) Chocolate and vanilla – $20 + 12 = 32$
 Strawberry, mint and banana – $16 + 4 + 8 = 28$
 Fred is wrong – the totals are not the same. More children chose chocolate and vanilla.

- c) The most popular filling would still be blueberry.
- d) Children may suggest adding a title or adding the key.
