- Ask simple geographical questions eg What is Blackpool like?
- Geography vocab
- Use primary and secondary sources of information to carry out research on Blackpool
- Mapping skills – locate Blackpool on a map and compare with location of Billinge
- Human/physical features of Blackpool
- Compass directions
- Locational/Directional language – routes on a map
- Devising of a map
- Simple fieldwork and observational skills

History

- Holidays in the past and understanding what this means using timelines
- Compare holidays in the present/past
- Look at books, videos, objects and artefacts to learn about holidays in the past
- Look at objects from the past and ask questions – What were they used for?

Science

- Animals – Name, describe and compare the structure of animals and sort them based upon their structure
- Identify and name and classify animals into fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds, and mammals based on their characteristics
- Identify and name a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores
