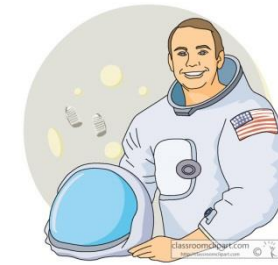

Year 2 National Curriculum Objectives for History: Children will be taught to:

Year 2 Areas of Study

- The Gunpowder Plot
- The First Moon Walk
- Poppy Day
- Explorers of Africa and Polar Regions

Chronological Understanding

- Understand and use the words past and present
- Sequence pictures and simple dates/times e.g. sequence the events of The Gunpowder Plot
- Order events using a simple timeline given by the teacher

Knowledge and Understanding of Events, People and Changes in the Past

- Use information to describe the past
- Describe the differences between then and now
- Use information to give reasons why people in the past may have acted in the way they did e.g. Why did Guy Fawkes plan to blow up the Houses of Parliament?
- Recount the main events form a significant event in history – The First Moon Walk; the Gunpowder Plot; Poppy Day

Historical Interpretation

- Look at and use books, pictures, photographs, the Internet, video clips and artefacts to find out about the past.

Historical Enquiry

- Identify different ways in which the past is represented
- Ask simple questions about the past
- Use a range of information to answer questions about the past.

Organisation and Communication

- Describe objects, people and events in history through writing, role-play, ICT, drawing and in speaking e.g. a newspaper report about The Gunpowder Plot and the First Moon Walk, hot seating Guy Fawkes
